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# FOREWORD

**Praise and Worship Songbook One** includes all of the songs from the following Integrity's Hosanna! Music recordings:

All Hail King Jesus  
To Him Who Sits on the Throne  
Glory to the King  
I Exalt Thee  
Give Thanks  
Glorify Thy Name  
You Are My God

Every song is arranged in four-part harmony (SATB) and can be easily performed by your choir or worship team. The four-part harmony also works well as a basis for piano and organ accompaniment. Cued notes have been added where necessary to help establish the "feel" of the song. Guitar chords are also provided.

Musicians should be encouraged to embellish these arrangements by improvising with the chord symbols. When there is a note under a slash (e.g., F/G), the note above the slash is the chord to be played by the upper register instruments (guitar, right hand of the piano, etc.). The note below the slash is to be played by the lower register instruments (bass guitar, organ pedals, left hand of the piano, etc.). For songs that flow smoothly with each other, a medley reference is listed on each appropriate page.

The **Praise and Worship Songbook** has many features to help you plan your worship services.

Index "A" lists all songs by key and tempo. Praise and worship times will flow more smoothly if you select songs that are closely related in key and tempo. Create medleys of songs rather than stopping after each song. Choose songs that are related thematically, such as:

Arise Shine	C major
Let Your Spirit Rise Within Me	F major
I Will Arise	F major
Let God Arise	A major

Index "B" lists the songs by topic, such as thanksgiving, joy, victory, etc. If you know the theme of your pastor's message, you can prepare the hearts of the people by focusing your worship on the same topic.

Index "C" lists songs by the first line of lyrics in case you are unsure of the title.

Index "D" lists the songs according to their scriptural references. If you are searching for a song featuring a specific scripture, you will find it listed in biblical order.

Index "E" lists copyright owners of the songs presented in this publication.

We wish to thank all those who have given their permission to print the songs in this book. Every effort has been made to locate the copyright owners. If any omissions have occurred, we will make proper corrections on future printings.


